

Coronavirus Update

During the Coronavirus Pandemic Supermax Healthcare Ltd has taken a proactive approach to the restrictions in place, and ensuring a Coronavirus secure workplace for our employees and anyone else on site.

Current measures on site are:

- Screens between desks and / or distancing of desks
- Hand Cleaning procedures
- Hand Sanitiser
- Training & Guidance given to those on site and working from home
- Strict Social distancing
- Restricted face to face meetings
- Visitors on site restricted to essential maintenance only
- Enhanced cleaning
- Signage around site to highlight that restrictions are in place.

Effective 24th September 2020, the following new measures are in place:-

- Everyone deemed able to work from home will be doing so.
- Unit 8 desks will be moved further apart to further restrict contact between essential staff.
- The Warehouse will be split into 2 separate teams (Bubbles), with no more than 6 per team, in keeping with the "Rule of Six" guidance. In the event of a suspected or confirmed Coronavirus case, the entire bubble will be sent home to isolate.
- Face Coverings will now be compulsory on site. The only exemptions are when people are sat at their desks or eating, drinking or smoking in designated areas.
- The warehouse opening hours will until further notice mirror the office therefore as of tomorrow the entire business will operate from 8:45am to 5:15pm.
- We will improve on all levels of sanitisation around the organisation.
- As a business we will be working on a programme of 'events' to ensure the business remains joined together as much as possible. Mental Health is a vital aspect of our Coronavirus response.
