

Reach, Evaluation and Authorisation of Chemicals (REACH)

Reach, Evaluation and Authorisation of Chemicals (REACH), is the European Community regulation for the control and safe use of chemicals. REACH legislation was finalised in December 2006 and has been in effect since June 2007.

Supermax Healthcare Limited is not a manufacturer of chemicals, but is a user of them during the manufacturing process and as such is fully aware of its responsibilities under REACH with regards to usages of chemicals and also the provision of safety data.

As per the 'Substances of very high concern' (SVHC) candidate list published by the European Chemicals Agency (Last amended on the July 16th, 2019) and as required by Article 33 of the REACH Regulation, Supermax Healthcare Limited confirms that our products do not currently contain in excess of 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) of the chemicals on the aforementioned candidate list.
